

# Parts of Speech Presentation!

With a small group assigned by the teacher, you will teach the class about one of the eight parts of speech (noun, verb, adjective, adverb, conjunction, interjection, pronoun, and preposition). You will use the ENTIRE class period to do this, so it's important to have a lot of different parts to your presentation and lesson. Make a plan, work together, and rely on each other!

## Minimum Requirements:

- Give a clear definition and examples of the part of speech.
- Show how the part of speech is used in a sentence.
- All students in the group need to have a speaking part in the lesson.
- Create a slideshow about the part of speech with Google Slides.
- Use additional visual and audio components—like a video or song.
- A reasonable and engaging assignment or activity for students to help them learn the part of speech (if you need a handout printed or posted, get it to me by Thursday, May 19). Be creative! In the past, we have seen games, skits, songs, videos, Kahoots, and more!

## Schedule:

<b>Dates</b>	<b>Activity</b>
Monday, May 16	Introduction to the project. Parts of speech and groups assigned. Begin planning with your group.
