How to use **your own pictures** for your Scratch backdrops:

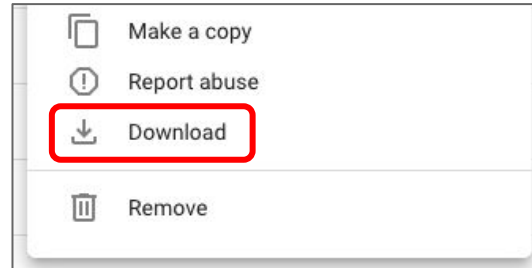
- Take pictures in **landscape** mode.



- Add the pictures to your **Google Drive**.



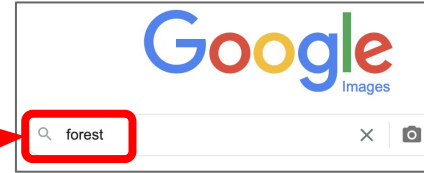
- **Download** them.



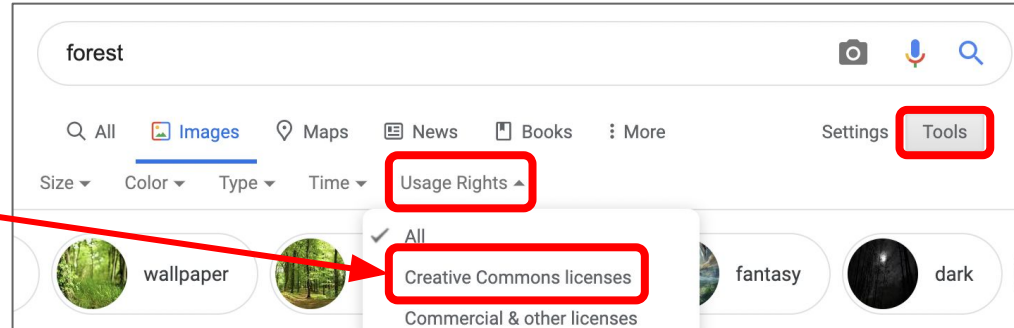

How to use **Google Images** for your Scratch backdrops:

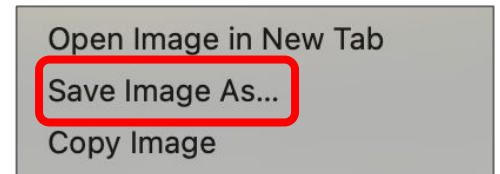
- Use **ONE word** to **search** for your background:



- Click **Tools > Usage rights > Creative commons licenses:**



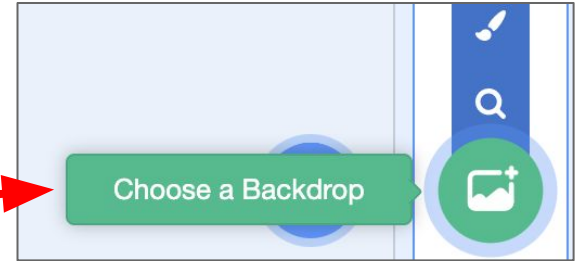
- When you find one you like:
click on the image > right-click > Save image as:



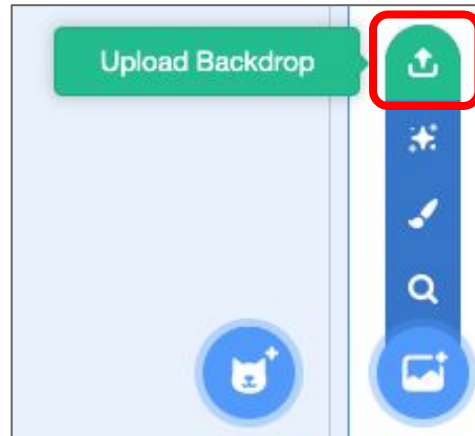

How to add your downloaded images to your **Scratch game**:

- In the **lower right corner** of your Scratch game, **hover** over the **Choose a backdrop** icon.



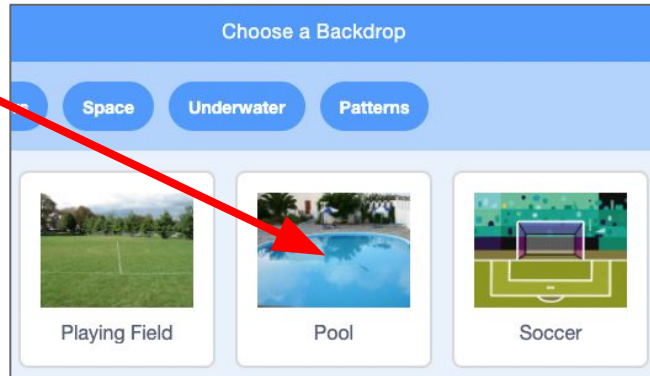
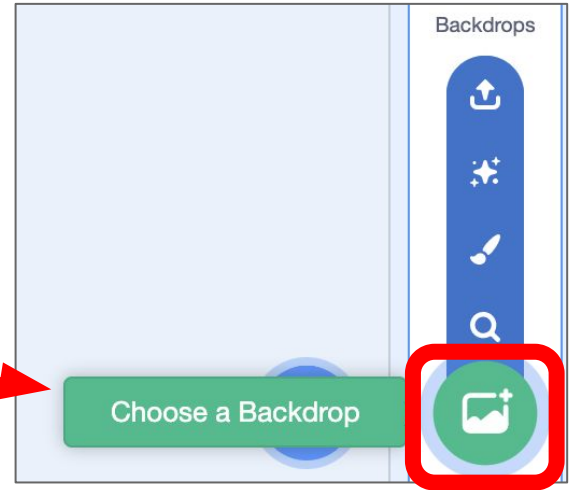
- Click on the **upload** icon.



- Choose your background from your **downloads**.

How to use **backdrops from Scratch**:

- In the **lower right corner** of your Scratch game, click the **Choose a backdrop** icon.
- When you find one you like, **click** to add it to your game.
