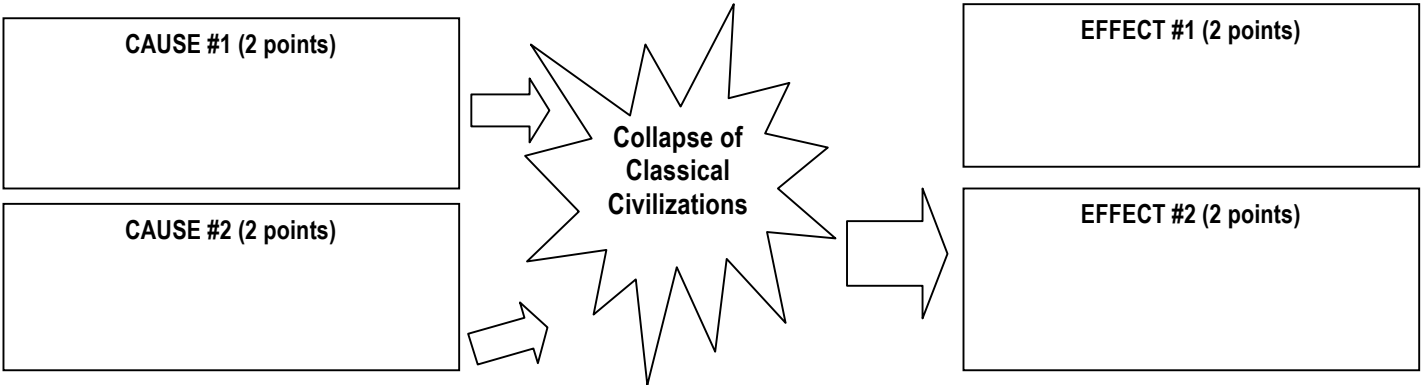

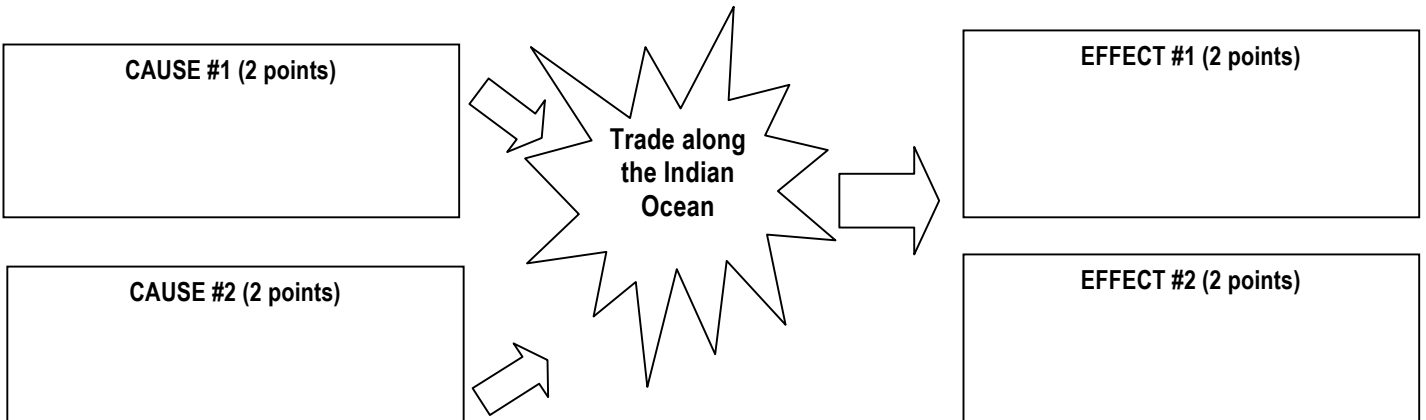

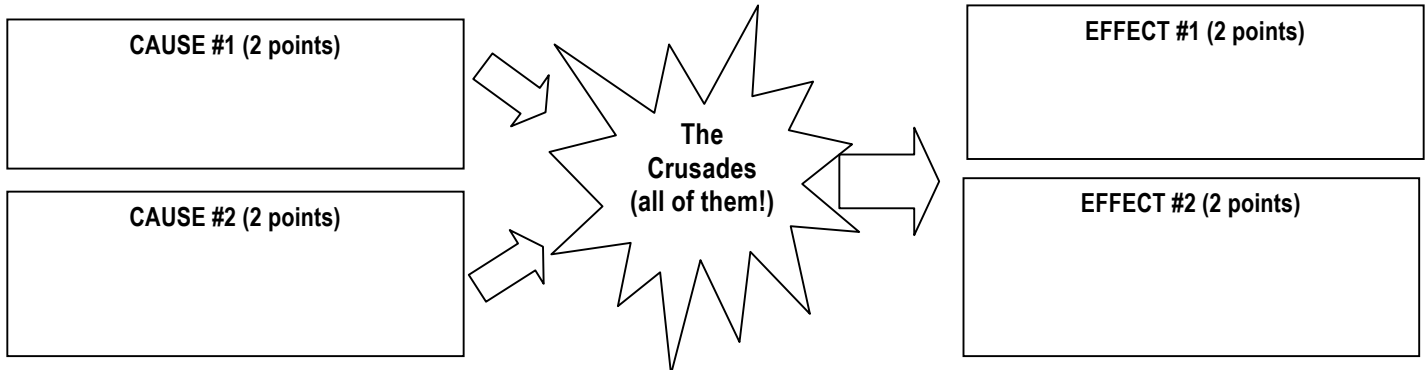
Collapse of Classical Civilizations Cause and Effect (8 points)

Thesis Statement	Takes a controversial position which is proven through argument	Takes a clear position, position is strong (not wishy washy!) and arguable	Position is ambiguous or changes throughout paper, question is restated, but not in author's own words	Not a statement—thesis worded as a question
Outside Info	Supports thesis with substantial, relevant, and accurate outside information	Supports thesis with relevant and helpful outside information	Supports thesis with limited, but appropriate, outside information	Provides minimal, irrelevant, or incorrect outside information
Analysis	Provides an effective analysis that answers all aspects of the question; thoroughly addresses counter-arguments	Provides analysis but may not devote equal weight to all parts of the question; addresses counter-arguments	Analysis is present but superficial; fails to address counter-arguments; does not sufficiently address all parts of the question	Little or no analysis; describes rather than analyzes; only answers one part of the question
