## Webpage Project



### Project Description:



Now that you know the basics of creating a personal Webpage, you are going to have the opportunity to create one from scratch. Unlike the practice one we created in class, you will have free-run on this project. There are a few guidelines and expectations, but all in all, this will be your own work. The webpage you create will be used and updated throughout this trimester. You will use it to reflect throughout the different projects you are assigned during this course. It will basically be your own personal bulletin board where you will post your finished products. Hopefully this will be a fun/creative way to interact.

### Requirements:

- 1.) You may choose any template you would like.
- 2.) You must include a Welcome Page, About Me Page, & Blog Page
  - a. **Welcome Page** – should explain what the purpose of this webpage is, what course it is for, etc. This section doesn't have to be very long and it shouldn't include information about you. Save that for the About Me Page.
    - i. Replace pictures with pictures of yourself
    - ii. The number of text boxes and pictures you have will depend on the theme you choose. Beware!
  - b. **About Me Page** – This page is pretty self-explanatory. Fill out all the sections of this page with information about you! You can change the categories if you feel they don't really apply to you. Delete anything that you don't need (links to picture for example, although we will add these later)
  - c. **Blog Page** – Make sure you fill everything out here as well. Choose pictures that best represent you. You can pull these from the Internet if you'd like. Be creative!
    - i. Your first blog will be a reflection on creating your first Webpage. This is a general impression of the process. What went well? What challenges did you face? What skills did you learn during this process? Etc...
    - ii. The second blog entry will be answering the Essential Question for this unit.
- 3.) Once you have completed your Webpage, upload it to the server.
