STANDARDS: Paragraph writing with a clear topic sentence, supporting sentences and closing sentence. The paragraph is at least 4 sentences long. Student varied the beginnings to the sentences (different word choices for the beginning). Strong words used, not boring and overused words. The basic writing conventions were followed: capitalization rules, end punctuation, spelling, writing is clean and neat, and letter size is consistent.
