Project Question and Tasks	What precautions should we take when we leave home? Students think of rules/ideas for safety when traveling from home to school.	What are the rules about talking to strangers? Students come up with ideas for what to do when they encounter strangers in real life.	What tools/items keep us safe in our homes? Students go home and conduct an audit of home safety devices (e.g. do your windows have locks?).	If we think we're in danger, what should we do? Students are presented with common scenarios and try to come up with plans for addressing them.	Who do we call for help? Students generate a list of emergency numbers. Students coelate their previous assignments into one safety guide.
