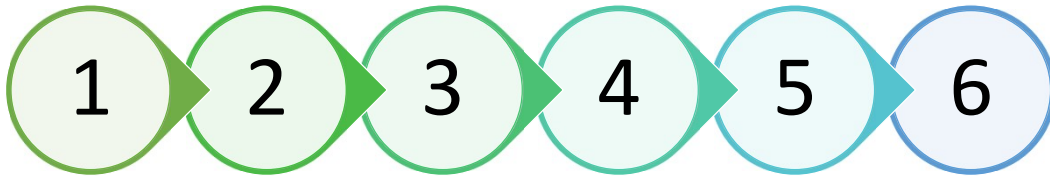





ILLUSTRATION 76. THE FORGETTING CURVE





ILLUSTRATION 77. DISTRIBUTED PRACTICE

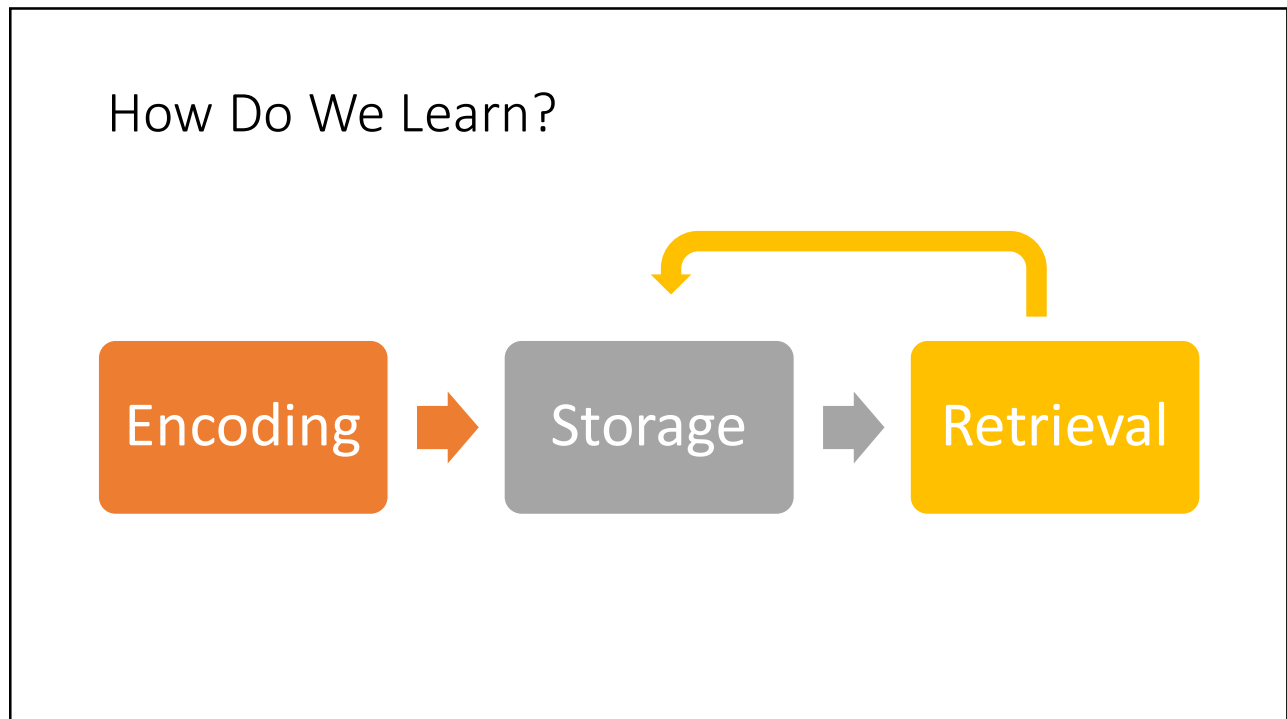



