Project Requirements

- 1. Curate the following elements:
 - At least 3 visual elements (e.g., photographs, artwork, graphics)
 - 2 written elements (e.g., poem, quote, recipe)
 - i. At least one element should be from a text we read this unit
 - 1 audio/visual element (e.g., song, video, movie)
 - i. This can be portrayed by an album photo or video still
 - A brief (1 sentence) description of each item.
- 2. Write an artist statement (400-500 words) that includes...
 - Your definition of what it means to be "local,"
 - An explanation of your choices and their significance,
 - An explanation of what you believe your kuleana is as a writer and reader in Hawai'i.
